You will have heard that we spoke to him by telephone yesterday. He told us that he was better, that he would be in the Clinic for a few days more and was them going to you for his convalescence.

Words fail to express the deep gratitude we feel your and your husband's wonderful goodness to our boy. We only hope that some day we may have an opportunity of thanking you personally.

I do not understand why the wound still has not healed so many days after the operation and should be extremely thankful if you would be so good as to give me more details. Forgive me for troubling you further.
